ART ON THE GREEN

At the COAL Board meeting on Monday night July 14th., the Board discussed the issue of allowing artists who show at Art on the Green to be exempt from Gallery sitting.

Bob Mussay, our Gallery manager, spoke with our past presidents to clarify the issue of sitting. Historically, showing at Art on the Green did not exempt artists from Gallery sitting. So, since we are presently having a hard time filling all of the sitting spaces--and have even had to cut back the hours the Gallery is open because of a reduced number of participating artists at the Gallery, the board decided to return to the previous guidelines which means that showing at Art on the Green does not exempt you from Gallery sitting. Board members and hanging committees will also be pitching in with this endeavor.

Since you did not have the correct information this month when you brought pieces to the Gallery for the show we are not asking that you sign up for sitting if you have not already done so. And we sincerely thank those of you who went ahead and signed up to sit this month anyway. When you submit your work for the August show and all future shows, you will be expected to sign up for a Gallery sitting date even if you are

showing at Art on the Green.

For purposes of selling at "Art on the Green" COAL members may include handmade artistic pieces such as ceramics, vases, mosaics, metal sculpture, wearable art, leather work and jewelry. Jewelry components must be hand crafted by the artist. These pieces may be shown at "Art on the Green" and are NOT acceptable to be shown at the COAL gallery. When showing at "Art on the Green" at least 25% of booth must include art that can be hung in the COAL gallery. All products for sale must be approved by the Chairperson and/or be listed on the "Statement of Acceptance" as juried.
