Kathryn Stovall Dennis, Ceramics - March Demo

I live in San Clemente near the ocean where I take much of my inspiration for my ceramic work. I surfed for many years and still play beach volleyball, so all things relating to the sea are special to me. Fish in particular are a recurring design motif in my work.

I have had my hands in clay for over 40 years and it never ceases to surprise and delight me! It is more of a partnership, one where you have to give up control to the medium and the process.

I really enjoy teaching at two community colleges. The students are always a challenge and never cease to amaze me. I learn as much from them as they do from me.

Located on the property of my home, I am lucky to have built a ceramic studio with kilns, wheels, ware racks, and enough space to teach small private classes. Besides teaching regular ongoing classes, I am a guest lecturer and perform workshops throughout the year at various art institutions, galleries, schools, etc.



I also participate in several juried shows each year, including the annual college faculty shows and at the "Kiln Opening Show" each year at AMOCA (American Museum of Ceramic Art, Pomona CA.)

Most of my ceramic work whether wheel thrown or hand built is altered in some way. I like pushing and pulling the malleable clay. It is a material like no other. It comes from our earth and is basically very flexible dirt. I like combining both disciplines and often incorporate found objects in my pieces. You have to have enough confidence to just let go.

Gallery Director's Column by Bob Mussay

We had originally scheduled a rummage sale on February's Take-In, but unfortunately we did not receive enough donations to make it worth our while. It is probably our fault for not getting the word out. We are going to try again for April. Please go through your supplies and, if there are things you no longer have any use for such as frames, easels, paint, brushes, matting etc., and they are in reasonably good condition, you should bring them into the Gallery between March 15 and March 23. They should all be stored neatly in the back room. Any items not sold will be discarded. No donations will be accepted on Take-In day in April.

Once again we had some suggestions turned in and I will try to answer them. Pertaining to the music and arrangement of art on the wall:

The music was chosen to be unobtrusive and a background only. Hence, classical was selected. However if the music is especially annoying to you, you can either leave it turned off or tune it to FM 98.1. Music should be played at a very low volume.

As to how the art is hung, we do start a standard distance from the ceiling and every effort is made to keep the art at a reasonable viewing height, but the distance depends on the amount of submissions we get in a month. Remember, outside of the August Show, which is a Juried Show, one of the benefits of membership is that if you enter, your art gets hung. For that reason sometimes it is lower than we all would like but is better than not accepting someone on the basis of space.

Members are again reminded that no one is to make any changes, additions or deletions to the calendar without the permission of the Gallery Director.
