

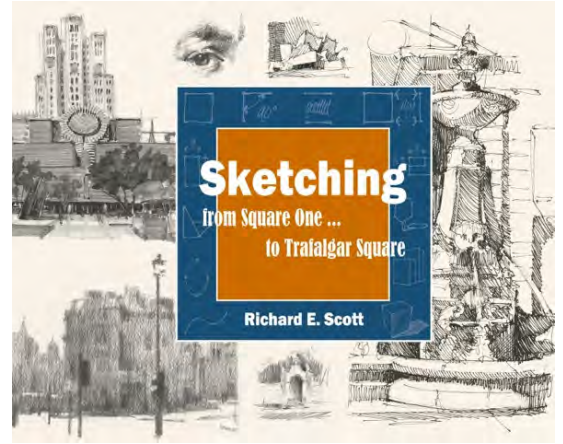

ARTIST RECOGNITION AND OPPORTUNITIES

- **Jacquie Thye** will be the featured artist at Carlsbad's Dove Library May 20-June 30. She has been a member of COAL for many years and will be exhibiting several of her award-winning photos, including architecture, landscapes, people, animals and travel in Europe, Asia, Africa and local sites. She attended the Portland Museum of Art School in Oregon and is a founding director of the nonprofit Carlsbad Sister City Ambassadors with cities in Futtsu, Japan and Karlovy Vary (Karlsbad), Czech Republic.
