Reminder from the Board: ORIGINALITY: All work submitted must be the artist's own creation and not copied from the work of other artists or cloned from copyrighted material. Class or group work must be the sole creation of the artist with no aid from the instructor or the group other than advice. Classroom work will be accepted in the regular monthly shows at the gallery, but will not be allowed at the Annual Open Juried Show. The integrity of the art work is the responsibility of the artist.

Gallery Director's Message by Bob Mussay

We will be holding our Seventh Annual Labor Day Art Festival in the courtyard of The Village Faire Shopping Center on August 30 and 31. This is a great opportunity for artists to display and sell. For those not familiar with this event, here are some of the main points to consider:

The hours are from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM each day. Cost of the space for both days is \$20 for members, \$25 for non-members. Single day cost is \$10 for members, \$15 for non-members. Spaces are approximately 10 feet by 4 feet. Tents are not permitted, but umbrellas are. Special areas will be provided for unloading and loading on both days and parking passes will be issued to allow parking in the employee lot. Overnight storage will be provided in the gallery on Saturday night. All sales belong to the artist. **COAL does not take any commission.** The exception is, if an artist uses the Gallery credit card machine, we must take out normal percentage.

Space is limited so please make your commitment as soon as possible. Contact Bob Mussay at 760 730 9274 or at Lazyram@aol.com.

Some Hosts are not completely following through when they process a sale so this might be time to review. All sales must be accompanied by a sales slip. They are located in the top left desk

drawer. If a cash sale is made and change is required, there is a brown envelop in that same drawer with \$45 in \$5 bills. If a sale is made by check, the Host needs to record the customer's Driver's license number on the check. On a credit card sale, the Host needs to record the last four digits of the card. There are complete instructions for handling a credit card sale on an instruction sheet located near the machine. The customer gets the white copy with their receipt and the other part of the sales slip along with the cash, check or signed credit card receipt goes into the red box, also in the top left desk drawer. If the art is left at the gallery for a pick up at another time, the I.D. card should be marked sold and a red dot affixed to it. Dots are in the top right hand desk drawer.

The artist should be called and informed of the sale. The art may be replaced. This pertains to card sets and shrink wraps as well. The exception is during the Open Show due to the fact that the art is juried in. Lastly the sale needs to be entered into the Sales Log. This is normally kept in the middle desk drawer.

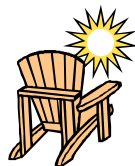
