## Lyndelle Stonick, Fine Artist - January Demo

Growing up with a love of nature and art, Lyndelle Stonick developed a natural sensibility for color, becoming very adept at conveying its subtle variations in hue and temperature, whether in oil, pastel or watercolor. She excelled as an artist in drawing, painting, printmaking and as a goldsmith making fine jewelry. Gifted with a talent for art since early childhood, Lyndelle won her first award at ten. That was soon to be followed by countless First Place and Best of Show Awards at prestigious shows and competitions that Lyndelle has entered throughout her career.

An honors graduate from CSUF, Lyndelle majored in Fine Art. While studying for her Masters, Fidelity Arts of Beverly Hills purchased and sold an edition of her prints that were marketed nationwide. In 1982 Lyndelle moved to Europe where she lived, taught and exhibited until 1988, beginning her work in pastel there.

Lyndelle has been featured in art books, newspapers and publications such as Southwest Art, Art Collectors Magazine, and the Pastel Journal. She has written articles, including one for Daniel Smith, produced a pastel DVD and has appeared on KOCE.



Lyndelle is also recognized for her teaching ability and has taught art for Saddleback College since 1995. Art organizations frequently see her expertise as a demonstrator and judge. She has shared her techniques at the Art Methods and Materials show as a professional artist, teaching in oils, watercolor and pastels, and has represented numerous art companies, such as Richeson & Co., as a working artist. She continues to work in Oils, Pastels and Watercolors. It was her passion for the pastel medium, however, that inspired her to become the founder and first president of the United Society of Pastel Artists (USPA) in Southern California.

I hope everyone had a happy, healthy Holiday Season and are ready for a productive 2014. COAL is going to have an art rummage sale in February on take-in day, February 3. We are asking all members to go through their art supplies to see if there is anything they no longer use and would be willing to donate. Donations can be frames, easels, paints, brushes, matting, etc. and should be in reasonably good conditions. Please don't bring us your junk!!

You may drop off donations in the back room of the Gallery during the month of January. No donations will be accepted on take-in day and all unsold supplies will be discarded.

All members are reminded that our pricing policy on all artwork including cards and shrink-wraps is in increments of fives, i.e. 10, 15, 20, etc. We are not equipped to deal in odd increments, i.e. 12, 14, 21, etc.

Please note that after you make a sale it is important to call the artist AND enter it into the sales log. This holds true for ALL SALES including cards and shrink-wraps. For example, when a member removes card packs and notices one set is missing, without a notation in the log, we don't know if a phone call wasn't made or if the card pack was possibly stolen.

Although she was a fine arts major in college, at 20, Lynne Crealock left the US for Europe to buy a boat. She spent 6 years at sea gathering knowledge of boats and the water. Lynne has covered the world - from England, through the canals of France, from Greece to Gibraltar, across the Atlantic Ocean to the Caribbean Islands and both coasts of Central America.

With her knowledge of boats and the sea, she began painting what she knew best and became a signature member of the American Society of Marine Artists, the ASMA. Ashore, she began painting landscapes and drawing figures. She continues to grow, abstracting her images and embracing more brilliant color. She still loves pure watercolor and returns from time to time to the beauty of its transparency.
