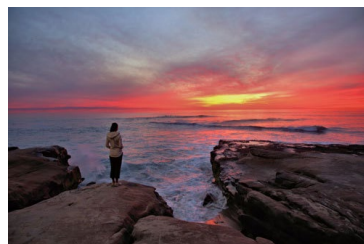


Photographer, Tom Smith, October Featured Artist
