Michael Seewald has been an artist all his life. He won his first 1st place award in painting at 13, his first national photography award at 19 and his first international competition (S.D. Museum of Photographic Art), at age 40. He won his second 'Best of Show', San Diego Fair Int'l Photo (besting over 3,300 world-wide entries), as well as the San Diego Art Institute's annual juried competition (in painting).

SHOW ENTRY RULES

Reminder from the Board: ORIGINALITY: All work submitted must be the artist's own creation and not copied from the work of other artists or cloned from copyrighted material. Class or group work must be the sole creation of the artist with no aid from the instructor or the group other than advice. Classroom work will be accepted in the regular monthly shows at the gallery, but will not be allowed at the Annual Open Juried Show. The integrity of the artwork is the responsibility of the artist. Enter up to 3 pieces at \$16 each. Maximum diagonal measurement for the combined entries is 110 inches.
