Kathryn Stovall Dennis, Sculptor - May Demo

"Clay is a unique and wondrous material to work with," says Kathryn. The appeal lies in her ability to begin with malleable organic earth and then give it structure. For Kathryn, the process is the joy, the resulting art simply the fun by-product.

The dominant historical and ethnic influences in her work are African, Chinese, Japanese and Celtic. The artist's love of the ocean also inspires water and fish imagery that come to life on colorful bowls, platters and sculpture. Her pieces convey a sense of whimsy coupled with deeper, contemplative feelings. Kathryn's extensive experience with glass has led her to literally fuse two mediums together, often adding fused glass accents to her vessels.

2015 Children's Show

Calling all parents, grandparents, friends and teachers of young artists ages 4 through 8th grade! Please spread the word about COAL's annual Children's Show in May. The event begins with Take-in on Saturday, May 2 from 11 a.m. until 4 p.m. On that day, each child may submit one piece of art created within the last year. Teachers may submit 10 pieces of art from students created in their classes. The art must fall into one of four categories –painting (watercolor, oil, acrylic); drawing (crayon, pencil, pen and ink, pastel); other 2-D art (collage, mixed media, photography, computer art); and 3-D art (ceramics, sculpture and other).

The show opens on May 6 and runs through May 30. All artists and their families and teachers are invited to the Children's Show Reception which will be held at the gallery on Sunday, May 17 from 3-5. At that time, all artists will be recognized with certificates, and prizes and ribbons will be awarded for exceptional art in the four age categories.
