In his eighth year as a watercolorist, Chuck has garnered hundreds of awards for his artwork and holds triple Signature status with the Western Federation of Watercolor Societies, National Watercolor Society and The San Diego Watercolor Society.

With a wide reputation for his "intuitive" watermedia stylings, Chuck was invited to display in a dual museum exhibit, "Nature Improved: San Diego Artists Interpret Our Landscape", at the Oceanside Museum of Art and San Diego History Center in Balboa Park. Two paintings were displayed during the Balboa Park Centennial at the Marston House Museum. Five watercolors graced the walls of the Muckenthaler Museum's NWS Invitational Plein Air Exhibition.



Chuck paints full-time, following his passion and building a reputation with large and intimate audiences. Brandishing a quick wit and a 6" brush, he flamboyantly embellishes his art with props borrowed from the crowd... like lipstick and coffee. His unique approach to creating makes his demonstrations and workshops entertaining as well as educational. He also serves as an art show juror.



Note to Artists: \$\$\$ IRS rules require COAL to file Form 1099 for any artist with sales of more than \$600 per year. You will be required to provide your social security number to COAL.
