January Demonstrator – David Darrow

Our January 9 demonstration will be a portrait in oil by long time COAL member, David R. Darrow.

David R. Darrow's last demonstration was in January 2008. It drew the largest crowd to date at that time. Painting a portrait from a live model, Darrow had a video camera pointed at his work, with a TV high on a stand for all to see. His knowledge of portraiture principles, color theory, painting techniques, and materials, along with his entertaining and informative manner of communicating these topics, all the while painting a remarkable likeness, makes for a most fascinating demonstration! You will laugh, learn, and come away with a stronger desire to paint.

In June of 2007, Darrow was featured in the cover story of the *San Diego Weekly Reader* in which the author Geoff Bouvier wrote about the experience of painting a portrait- from both sides of the canvas. You can read the entire article on Darrow's website: www.darrowart.com/paintings/reader.

In about February or March of 2008, Darrow set out on a technically experimental venture- a live, multi-camera, 'streaming video' broadcast from his painting studio. In April, he launched the *Dave the Painting Guy* show (http://DaveThePaintingGuy.com) and now broadcasts live from his Encinitas studio three nights a week to a growing audience, members of which can log in free from their own computers and text chat with Dave and other viewers from literally around the globe. Viewers tune in from all across the USA, Canada, Australia, France, Israel, Croatia, Greece, Germany, and the UK to watch and learn from Dave.

This year's demonstration promises to be informative and entertaining while Darrow paints a 2-hour portrait from a live model. Darrow, an illustrator for 17 years has reinvented himself as a portrait painter in 2000. He has won many awards from COAL gallery including positions of Best of Shows, First, and Second Places. He will have giclées of his work available at a discount for this event and will again donate a large framed signed giclée for our raffle.

He spoke passionately about knowing the essence of the subject. He taught us to use bigger brushes and prepare larger amounts of paint. Just watching him paint, gave me the awful and wonderful feeling that learning is forever.
