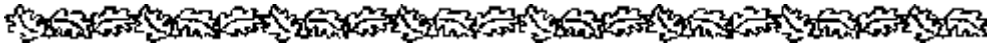
## Message from Publicity Chair

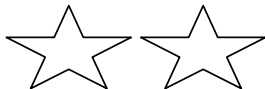
