Needing one final class to complete the requirements for my B.A. in another field, I "happened" to take a printmaking class. I knew nothing about the genre but it wasn't long before I was hooked. I fell in love with printmaking.



Since then I've taken many semesters dedicated to the craft. While still very much a student, I continue to enjoy the hands-on, contemplative work, the surprise of pulling a new print, the reward of seeing effort, experience and innovation unite. I'm especially gratified when the registration is right on, the press pressure is perfect, and when I haven't gotten inky fingerprints on the luscious white paper! All work is printed on quality BFK Rives paper. In addition, I often use colorful imported papers with wonderful textures; or I may print on my own handmade paper.

Finally, any introduction to me would be incomplete without mentioning my artist-husband, Hyatt Moore (www.hyattmoore.com). Over our forty-plus years of marriage, he's always urged me to pursue art, even when I didn't see myself as an artist. Bravo! There were more sales of art during our March Member Show than there have been in a single show since 2003! Is the economy picking up? Are people buying art again? Was our art in the Member Show just too good to pass up? Maybe it's all of the above. I'm proud to have my work in the COAL Gallery, and I'm proud to be its Gallery Director. I love the comments of people who come into the gallery for the first time and comment on how good our artists are. I love hearing that our show judges complain at how hard it is to judge the show because the work is consistently of top quality.

Let's keep it that way. I can't tell you how to be a better artist – you're doing fine on that score all by yourself! - but I can tell you how to be a better gallery host: Reread or review our procedures in the book marked "Gallery Procedures" -white binder now -- on the reception desk. Welcome visitors walking in the door and, if possible, invite them to fill out a People's Choice nomination. People's

Choice gives the guest the opportunity – or excuse – to really look at the work and to think about what they like in art. Call the artist when you make a sale - share the good news! And *please* return your parking permit at the end of your shift. It bugs me when we run out of permits and you have them in your car! The host after you appreciates this too.

I think excellent artists want to be excellent hosts too. And when you do, everybody wins, and perhaps somebody sells a piece of work as a result.
